Dr. Fournier received his medicine diploma from the University of Montreal in 1986. At the end of his residency he practiced in Matagami, north of Quebec from 1988 till 1990. Back to Montreal, he practiced in a private clinic in the eastern part of Montreal. He also was part of the medical trainer staff at the family medicine unit of Maisonneuve-Rosemont from 1990 till 2006 where he was head of the service of family medicine. He joined, as associate professor, Notre-Dame hospital family medicine unit since 2007.

Involved in continuing medical education at all levels, Dr. Fournier participated in the development of ten workshops FMC of preceptorship, conferences and was President of the Scientific Committee of the 25th Annual Scientific Assembly - Quebec College of Family Physicians.
